Sevierville Convention Center

The <u>Sevierville Convention Center</u>, located adjacent to Stone Hill Lodge, offers corporate meeting and group planners 200,000 square feet of flexible meeting and entertainment space ideal for large events and trade shows, expositions, competitive arts and more.

The 108,245 square-foot exhibit hall is perfect for trade shows or can accommodate up to 7,000 guests for a sit-down banquet, while a 19,290 square-foot ballroom can accommodate up to 1,120 for a plated-dinner function. Both the exhibit hall and the ballroom can be separated into smaller spaces via a flexible air-wall system.

For smaller or more intimate gatherings, private meeting rooms are available and range in size from 511 to 1,022 square feet. For a more unique setting or function, there is also a rotunda and pre-function space.
